Day 1 -House

"God has also given examples of believers: Pharaoh's wife, who said, 'Lord, build me a house near You in the Garden. Save me from Pharaoh and his actions; save me from the evildoers,'" -Surah Tahrim 66:11

EXPLANATION

This is the dua that Asiya, peace be upon her, made to Allah while she was being tortured by Firwan . It was at that moment Allah then opened the skies and allowed her to see her home in Paradise. She was a very righteous and pious woman who attained perfect iman (faith) according to Prophet Muhammad, peace be upon him. He stated that she is one of the four greatest women that ever lived.

HOW CAN WE BUILT A HOUSE IN PARADISE?

Prophet Muhammad (ﷺ) : "and I guarantee a home in the middle of Jannah for one who abandons lying even for the sake of fun"

Prophet (Sallallahu Alaihi wa Sallam) said: "If anyone recites Surah al-Ikhlâs ten times, a palace will be built for him in Paradise because of it"

Day 2 -Eye

Have We not made for him a pair of eyes?-
Surah Balad 90:8

EXPLANATION

Allah tells us in this ayah that He has given us two eyes, Allah has created our eyes so perfectly.

EXPLANATION

SOME AMAZING FACTS ABOUT OUR EARS

- Your outer ear never stops growing throughout your lifetime.

- Ears are self-cleaning. This means you do not need to clean out your ears

Day 4- Horse

Day 5-One

Allah tells In this Ayah that He is the only God, and that He has no partners or equals. He is Allah, the One and Only, the Sustainer, and there is no deity worthy of worship except Him. He is the Most Gracious - Ar-Rahman, the Most Merciful - Ar-Rahim.

without His knowledge,-Surah An'am 6:59**

EXPLANATION

Allah tells In this Ayah that He kows about each leaf that falls, from each plant or tree that bears it. He also knows when, how and where it will fall.He is all Knowing.

Day 7-Salt

**"And He is the One Who merges the two bodies of water: one fresh
and palatable and the other salty and bitter, placing between them
a barrier they cannot cross "-Surah Furqan 25:53**

EXPLANATION

Allah tells In this Ayah that He has created two kinds of water ,sweet and salty. The sweet water is like that in rivers, springs and wells, which is fresh, sweet, drinkable water. And other water is salty, bitter and not easy to swallow. This is like the seas that are known in the east and the west, the Atlantic Ocean and the Straits that lead to it, the Red Sea, the Arabian Sea, the Persian Gulf, the China Sea, the Indian Ocean, the Mediterranean Sea, the Black Sea .

Day 8-Cow

‘He said,’ “Joseph, O man of truth! Interpret for us ‘the dream of’ seven fat cows eaten up by seven skinny ones; and seven green ears of grain and ‘seven’ others dry, so that I may return to the people and let them know.”

Surah Yusuf 12:46

EXPLANATION

Yusuf (alai) was a Prophet of Allah .Allah always gives special gifts to the prophets. He also gave the Prophet Yusuf (alai) a special gift .He taught Yusuf (alai) to understand dreams.

One Day the king of Egypt had a strange dream. This what he saw :There were seven fat cows in a field .Then came seven thin cows and they ate the seven fat cows .After that ,the king saw seven green ears of corn. Then these seven green ears of corn turned yellow.

The next day,king called all the wise men.He told them about the dream. He asked them:"what does this dream means? .Nobody knew the answer .

Day 9-Son

EXPLANATION

Allah tells in this Ayah how Luqman advised his son. His full name was Luqman bin `Anqa' bin Sadun, and his son's name was Tharan, Allah granted him wisdom. Luqman advised his son, the closest and most beloved of all people to him, who deserved to be given the best of his knowledge. So, Luqman started by advising him to worship Allah Alone, and not to associate anything with Him.

Day 10-Head

He said : "My Lord! Surely my bones have become brittle, and grey hair has spread across my head, but I have never been disappointed in my prayer to You, my Lord!" -Surah Maryam 19:4

EXPLANATION

Allah tells in this Ayah how Prophet Zakariyyah made dua to Allah asking for a son though he is very old (he had gray hair spread all over his head).

Prophet Zakariya (AS) was one of the prophets from the Bani Israel. He was a carpenter. and a very righteous person., he prayed to Allah and worshiped Him as a true believer..

Zakariya (AS) was old. His wife was unable to bear children. However, he still made the dua to Allah because he knew that nothing is impossible for Allah.

Day 11-Cave

Remember¹ when those youths took refuge in the cave, and said, "Our Lord! Grant us mercy from Yourself and guide us rightly through our ordeal."

Surah Al-Kahf 18:10

EXPLANATION

Allah tells us in this Ayah about the seven young men who ran away from their people to protect their lives and sake of their religion when they entered the cave they asked Allah to show mercy and kindness towards them.

Day 12-Meat

And it is He who subjected the sea for you to eat from it tender meat and to extract from it ornaments which you wear. And you see the ships plowing through it, and [He subjected it] that you may seek of His bounty; and perhaps you will be grateful. Surah Nahl 16:14

Allah tells us in this Ayah how he has created sea as a benefit for us and we are allowed to eat fresh seafood that sea provides us even if it dead or alive .

Day 13-Mosquito

Surely Allah does not shy away from using the parable of a mosquito or what is even smaller. As for the believers, they know that it is the truth from their Lord. Surah Baqarah 2:26

EXPLANATION

Allah gives us in this ayah about a special example of Mosquito and He mentions that the people who believe in Him know that it is the truth .

Allah gives us its example in the Quran, to show us how this little creature has an extremely complicated nature.

SOME AMAZING FACTS ABOUT MOSQUITOS

- The deadliest animal in the world
- Only female mosquitoes bite humans
- There are 3,000 species of mosquitoes around the world
- The average mosquito weighs about 2.5 milligrams
- Mosquitoes fly an estimated 1 to 1.5 miles per hour.

Day 14- Pen

الَّذِي عَلَّمَ بِالْقَلَمِ

"Who taught by the pen"
Surah Al Alaq: 4

EXPLANATION

It is a great favor of Allah that starting man's creation from a most insignificant state, He made him possessor of knowledge which is the noblest attribute of creation, and He made him not only possessor of knowledge but also taught him the art of writing by the use of pen, which became the means of propagation, progress, dissemination and preservation of knowledge on a large scale. Had He not given man the knowledge of the art of pen and writing (by inspiration) his intellectual faculty would have stagnated, and it would have had no opportunity to develop, expand and become a means of transmission of knowledge from one generation to the next and make future progress.

SOME AMAZING FACTS ABOUT PEN

- The Prophet (saws) said, "The first thing created by Allah was the pen, then, He ordered it to write, so it wrote everything that will happen till the Day of Judgment." (narrated by Tirmidhi, Abu-Dawud, and Ahmad).
- The first recorded instance of a pen with self-contained ink is in 953. Al - Nu'man, an advisor to Sultan Al - Mu'izz of Egypt, recounts the commissioning of the construction of first fountain pen.

- An average cloud weighs 216 thousand pounds. An average storm cloud weighs 105.8 million pounds.
